After 3 years trying to find a company with a culture that was a fit for him, he found it, that company closed their doors. This left Paui in financial distress including losing his home and purpose.

Fast Forward to today, after a call from VA Social Services, NXTStep Vets was called in to assist the veteran. I am pleased to say that Paul is now employed and living in a temporary hotel paid by NXTStep Vets and driving a car donated by NXTStep Vets.

Paul is looking forward to continued mentorship in his career, finances and personal struggles.

Shawn Reese Army Combat Veteran

When you meet SGT Michael S Reese, he has a laugh and smile that is contagious. Through conversations with him you know that he has a huge heart with a turmoiled past. SGT (Shawn) Reese was an Infantryman with the 101st Airborne Division fighting "Bastongne" Regiment from 2001-2007. Hvaing served 3 deployments to Iraq, Shawn had experienced loss and devastion that no American should.

After departing the Army in 2007, Shawn tried to engage the workforce but had trouble adapting. In 2008, the VA placed him on Temporary unemployability. 17 years later, he is still on "temporary" unemployability. He made his children his purpose and now that his children are grown, it put him in a difficult mental spot.

Shawn is our first Alumni with NXTStep Vets. Shawn is currently going from VFW to VFW looking for ways to improve Branch Hill Post 5354. Shawn is currently on a long path to ensure he strives. Expenses

NXTStep Vets is scheduled to hold 4 retreats in 2025. At a cost of approximately \$5,500 per retreat, we need a minimum yearly operating cost of \$22,000 per year. Even though we have accomplished half that budget, we have been busy assisting veterans get back on their feet.

Recently we have helped one of our Alumni with attorney costs to help get his life back on track. We have also donated a car and 2 weeks housing for a veteran.
