Michael (Mike), is a Navy veteran having servedfrom 1990-1997. Mike is an aircraft mechanic whom had no problem becoming employed aftar transition. Mike took his talents gained in the Navy and thrived financially. 20 years later, his prior issues left him to a mental collapse. In 2024, Mike hit rock bottom when he becamse homeless. Mike has never registered with the VA or sought out help as a veteran.

I took Mike in November 2024 while Ohio's Temps hit the teens. Mike was living in a tent. NXTStep Vets has picked Mike up by giving him confidence in himself and others. Mike is currently under NXTSteps housing program and is currently seeking employment.

There is still a long road for Mike ahead. He is starting to see his future but we must help him get the care he needs to ensure he is mentally ready to thrive again.


